Transparent Language Online teaches over 110 languages. This includes English as a Second Language. It has tourist and beginner levels for all languages. Some languages have advanced and professional levels.

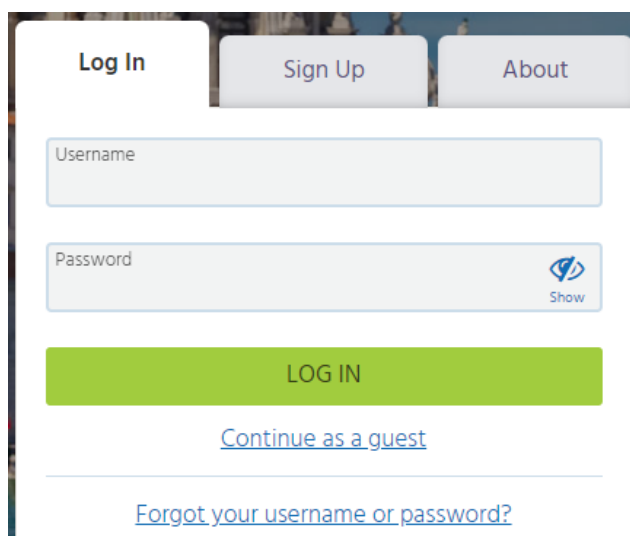
Transparent Online teaches listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills.

There are mobile apps for iOS and Android devices.

You will need to use a computer or a phone that has a microphone to do some activities.

Logging in

To use [Transparent Language Online](#), click on the link and choose Login or Sign Up.

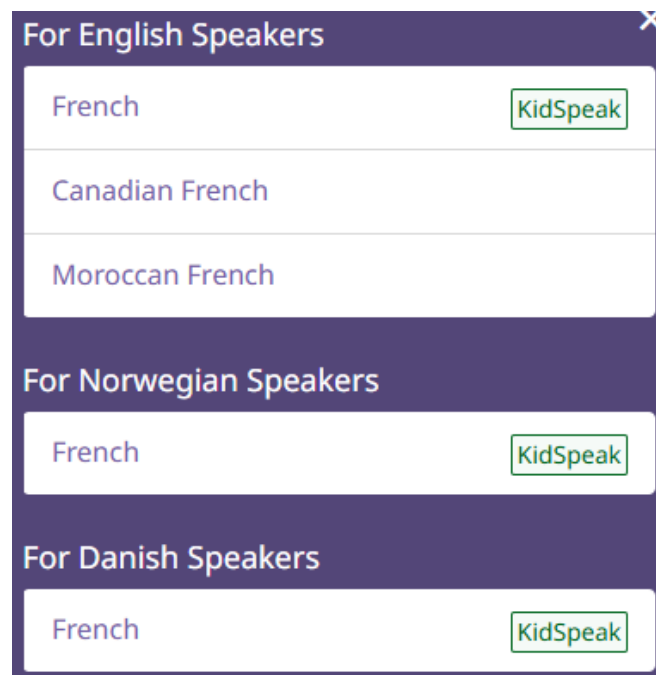
You can choose a language the first time you login.

Click on a language to see different dialects. This means different versions of the same language. For example, Arabic has Levantine, Egyptian, Iraqi, and Modern Arabic.

Some languages may be transliterated. This means a language using a different alphabet. For example, Arabic using the English alphabet.

Some languages also have Kidspeak. This is a course for children.



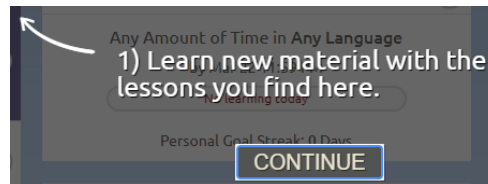
Click on the language you want to learn.

It will run a tutorial the first time you use it. It will point out different features that you might like to use.

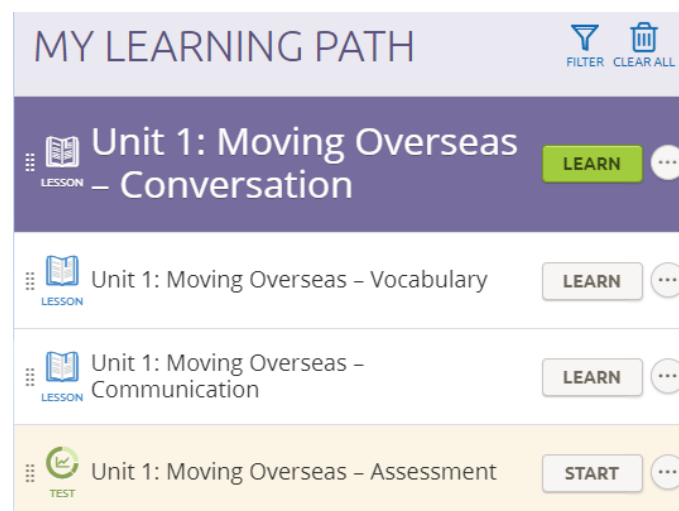


Press **Continue** to go through the tutorial, or click on the cross icon to quit the tutorial.



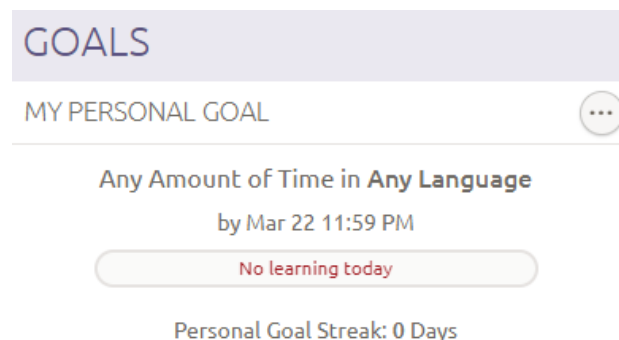
Home page

On the home page, which is also the Learning tab, you have different sections. The main section is the Learning Path. This is where you find your lessons and tests.



Other sections include Goals, Learned Vocab, Practice, and Achievements.

Goals lets you set how much time you want to study. It also shows how many days you have used Transparent Language in a row.



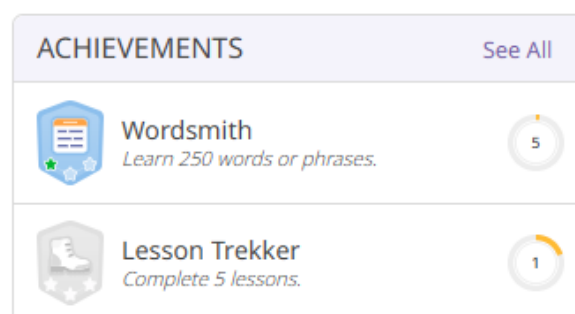
Learned Vocab adds new words from your lessons. You can add new words you learned somewhere else.



Practice lets you practice different types of activities.



Achieves shows badges that help motivate you. When you have reached a milestone, you get a badge.



Starting a lesson

Choose a lesson or test from the Learning Path and click Learn. It is usually best to start from the beginning, but you can skip activities if you want to.



The first page of lessons will usually cover what you will learn.

Conversation: Listen to the conversation and review the associated vocabulary.

Vocabulary: Practice the more difficult words and phrases from the conversation.

Communication: Practice the full conversation as one of the characters.

In the *Moving In* topic you will be focusing on the following communicative skills:

- Making inquiries about accommodations on the phone and/or email;
- Describing differences between types of accommodation;
- Asking about and describing features found in a home;
- Asking questions related to a rental agreement;
- Discussing necessary bills and utilities;
- Expressing opinions using expressions like "definitely", "absolutely" or "not at all..."

Click on Start Learning in the bottom right corner to start the lesson.

START LEARNING

Activities may change with each lesson. Some involve choosing an answer, clicking on a word and dragging it to the right place, or typing the answer in. Other questions will ask you to listen and record your answer.

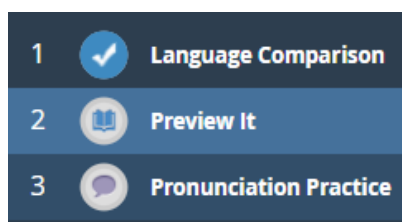
