Get hands-on with the latest technologies and techniques for recording digital content. Students will learn how to document digital stories using cameras, microphones and recording equipment, while learning to interview and share stories through the practice of podcasting.

Come to Liverpool City Library, Liverpool Regional Museum (or we can come to your school), where objects from our galleries and collections will inspire reflection on the past, the present and the future. Help your students share their perspective on current affairs and identify their hopes and dreams for the future of Liverpool.

Content created will be collected, compiled, and composed into a highlight reel that will be displayed online to celebrate the Council's 150th anniversary on June 27, 2022 – make sure your class is part of the action!
