Finding a language

From the home page, you can sort by languages. There are five options for browsing:

- Default
- Latest Release
- Most Popular
- Sort A-Z
- Sort Z-A

You can also search for a language in the search bar.

Sort: Default | Latest Release | Most Popular | Sort A - Z | Sort Z - A

Search:

All languages are shown with a flag, the language written in the native language and spelling, and with the English translation of the language.



Click on the flag to find all titles in that language.



You can use the same options to sort through the titles. The titles are given in both languages, and you'll see what age the book is appropriate for.

Some titles will offer a Bilingual option, which will read the story out in both languages.

Click on the language you wish the story to be read in, and a video will open.

Finding English only books

On the right-hand side of most pages, you'll see two options for English-only books, spoken in different accents.



Click on the accent you want, and it will provide a list of books.

Select your book to open the video.

Sign Languages

In the top right corner of the website, you will see links to Books, Sign, and Activities.

BOOKS SIGN ACTIVITIES

These are also found with the rest of the languages, but you can go here to see which stories have different sign language translations. Australian sign language is Auslan.



Watching videos

The videos will look like an open book, taking up the main part of the page.



There will be a description of the book if you scroll past the video.

Activities

In the top right corner of the website, you will see links to Activities next to sign.

BOOKS SIGN ACTIVITIES

There are games available through the Activities tab.

If you wish to download the activity to do offline, choose Downloads.



It will then give you a list of options. Click download to save to your computer to print or click watch to find the related video.

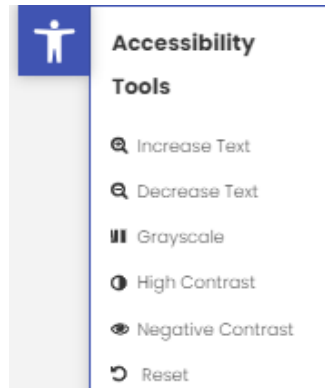


If you want to do the activity on the computer, choose Online. It will open an interactive screen. Click Play to start playing the game.



Accessibility

On the right-hand side of all pages, you will see a white person on a blue background, moving as you scroll through the page. Click on this to find the accessibility options.



- Increase text to make the font bigger.
- Decrease text to make the font smaller.
- Grayscale to make the website black and white.
- High contrast to change the website's colours to high contrast.
- Negative contrast to change the website's colours to negative contrast.
- Reset to change any of these settings back to the default.

Translations

At the top of all pages, you will see the USA flag next to the word English, with a drop down menu available by clicking on the arrow down. This lets you translate the whole website, but not the videos, to one of the languages available.
