Absolute Basic Subjects

Week 01: Introduction to Computers

Week 02: Introduction to the Internet

In this class, you'll learn how emails use the internet to send notes, letters, photos and more, no postage required, all over the world instantly.

This class will teach you the essentials of what a smartphone is and how to use one. You will also learn all about apps to get more out of your phone and tablet.
