



Good Reading Magazine

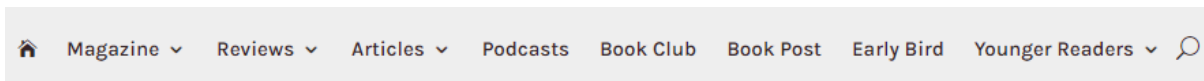
Good Reading has become an authority on Australian and international fiction, non-fiction and kids' books. They produce book reviews, articles, and author interviews in their magazines, and on their website, provide useful information to help people decide what they might want to read next.

Website

When you click on the link, it will take you to the [Good Reading website](#).

The website has a toolbar at the top which provides three useful sections: Magazine, Reviews, and the magnifying glass icon for searching.

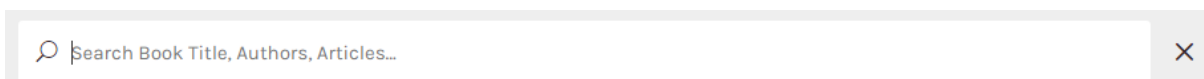


There are also useful headings to find more information.

- Articles: All articles posted in the magazines, not just reviews. This can be filtered the same way as the Reviews.
- Podcasts: Good Reading publishes podcasts on books, and the information on how to listen can be found here.
- Book club: Get ideas for your next book club by seeing what Good Reading recommends.
- Book Post: Book Post is a book subscription service that delivers a book we love, straight to your door, hand-picked by the bestselling book review magazine in Australia. You can find all information here.
- Early Bird: The Good Reading Early Bird program provides access to new books before they are available to everyone else. The details are available here.
- Younger Readers: Find content aimed at children and young adults.

Search

Click on the magnifying glass to search for book titles or authors to find any articles published in any of Good Reading's magazines or website, regardless of audience.



This will bring up a list of results. Click on Read More to read the article.

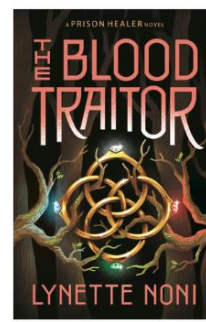

Browsing
